Family of Faith revisited

**Dear members and friends
of Immaculate Heart of Mary Parish:**

On December 2015, we completed the active fundraising phase of our Family of Faith campaign. The campaign at our parish raised a total of \$195,431.00 in cash and pledges, or 122% of our goal.

It is projected that when all these pledges are fulfilled, a total of \$65,648.00 will be returned to this parish to use for our own needs.

In fact, we have already received \$12,638.36 which was used to furnish the renovated parish hall and new servery with tables, chairs, kitchen cabinets and counters, plumbing for a new sink, and to purchase two new warming ovens and a refrigerator.

Your generous support and prayers for the success of the Family of Faith campaign helped make this effort truly successful at our parish. However, some of your pledges are not being fulfilled because of missing payment information and changed credit card numbers.

If your contribution belongs in this category, you have probably already received one or more letters from the Family of Faith Donation Processing Centre. If you are able to fulfill your pledge, please contact the Processing Centre as soon as possible at campaign@archtoronto.org or 416.934.3400 ext.555 to provide the missing information and catch up with the redemption process.

Please be aware that pledges that are not fulfilled will affect the collected total, and in this case, the amount that the parish stands to receive will be reduced accordingly.

If your financial or personal circumstances have changed and you feel you can no longer honor your commitment, please contact the Processing Centre and inform them of your decision (you do not need to offer any explanation). This will save time and trouble for all concerned so that they will know not to continue to send you letters about this matter.

Thank you to all who have contributed to the Family of Faith campaign. Your contributions support both our local parish but also the continuing mission of the Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Toronto.
