PRAYER TO ST MICHAEL THE ARCHANGEL

 \mathcal{O} n September, in view of the crisis and scandals that have shaken the Church, Pope Francis encouraged the People of God to return to the traditional prayers for protection from the works of Satan: in particular, the Prayer to St Michael the Archangel and Sub tuum praesidium.

Sub tuum praesídium confúgimus, sancta Dei Génetrix; nostras deprecatiónes ne despícias in necessitátibus, sed a perículis cunctis líbera nos semper, Virgo gloriósa et benedícta.

(We fly to Thy protection, O Holy Mother of God. Do not despise our petitions in our necessities, but deliver us always from all dangers, O Glorious and Blessed Virgin.)

With this request for intercession the Holy Father asks the faithful of all the world to pray that the Holy Mother of God place the Church beneath her protective mantle: to preserve her from the attacks by the devil, the great accuser, and at the same time to make her more aware of the faults, the errors and the abuses committed in the present and in the past, and committed to combating without any hesitation, so that evil may not prevail.

The Prayer to Saint Michael was written by Pope Leo XIII:

Sancte Míchael Archángele, defénde nos in próelio; contra nequítiam et insídias diáboli esto praesídium. Imperet illi Deus, súpplices deprecámur, tuque, Prínceps milítiae caeléstis, Sátanam aliósque spíritus malígnos, qui ad perditiónem animárum pervagántur in mundo, divína virtúte, in inférnum detrúde. Amen. (Saint Michael Archangel, defend us in battle, be our protection against the wickedness and snares of the devil; may God rebuke him, we humbly pray; and do thou, O Prince of the heavenly host, by the power of God, cast into hell Satan and all the evil spirits who prowl through the world seeking the ruin of souls. Amen.)



Cardinal Collins has also suggested that the St Michael prayer may be said at the conclusion of celebrations of the Eucharist. In order to support this, the parish is providing holy cards of the prayer which are available at the entrance of the church so that parishioners can participate in this devout practice.
