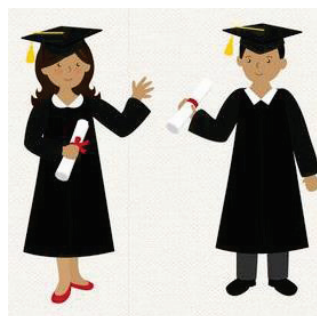

What is Holy Communion?
Holy Communion is the receiving of Jesus Christ in the sacrament of the Holy Eucharist. As food is needed to nourish our bodies, it is also necessary to nourish our souls with spiritual food.

Our Divine Savior so loved us that He gave us Himself in the sacrament of the Holy Eucharist, His own body and blood as food for our souls. As Christ is entirely present under the appearances of bread, and also entirely present under the appearances of wine, we receive Him whole and entire under the appearances of bread alone or of wine alone.

What is necessary to receive Holy Communion worthily?

It is necessary to be free from mortal sin, to have a right intention and to obey the Church's laws on the fast required before Holy Communion out of reverence for the body and blood of Our Divine Lord.

Does he who knowingly receives Holy Communion in mortal sin receive the body and blood of Christ and His graces?

He who knowingly receives Holy Communion in mortal sin receives the body and blood of Christ, but he does not receive His graces and commits a grave sin of sacrilege.

What should we do to receive more abundantly the graces of Holy Communion?

We should strive to be most fervent and to free ourselves from deliberate venial sin.

When may Holy Communion be received without fasting?

Holy Communion may be received without fasting when one is in danger of death, or when it is necessary to save the Blessed Sacrament from insult or injury.

What should we do after Holy Communion?

We should spend some time adoring Our Lord, thanking Him, renewing our promises of love and of obedience to Him, and asking Him for blessings for ourselves and others.

What are the chief effects of a worthy Holy Communion?

- A closer union with Our Lord and a more fervent love of God and of our neighbor;
- An increase of sanctifying grace;
- Preservation from mortal sin the and remission of venial sin;

- The lessening of our inclinations to sin and the help to practice good works.
- When are we obliged to receive Holy Communion?
During Easter time each year and when in danger of death, we are obliged to receive Holy Communion.

Why is it well to receive Holy Communion often, even daily?

It is well to receive Holy Communion often, even daily, because this intimate union with Jesus Christ, the Source of all holiness and the Giver of all graces, is the greatest aid to holy life.

How should we show our gratitude to Our Lord for remaining always on our altars in the Holy Eucharist?

We should show our gratitude to Our Lord for remaining always on our altars in the Holy Eucharist, by visiting Him often, by reverence in church, by assisting every day at Mass when this is possible, by attending parish devotions, and by being present at Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament.
