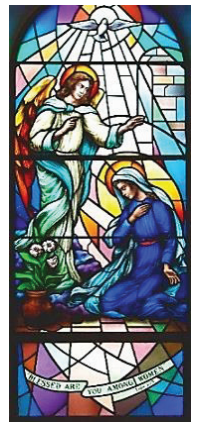

- 6 ventilation windows

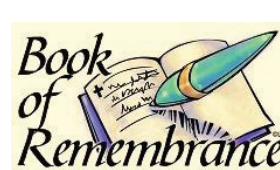


Donations are still being accepted in covering the cost and preserving our parish heritage. Your generosity will be greatly appreciated!
