We are looking for children ages 5-11 to be part of the



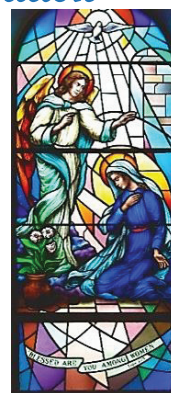
Christmas pageant this year. If your child is interested in being part of the pageant, please see handout at the back of the church. If you have any additional questions, please

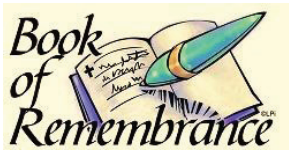
CWL Christmas Bazaar

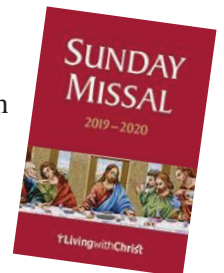
