

Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God



Although New Year's Day is not celebrated by the Church, this day has been observed as a holy day of obligation since early times due to the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God.

Today, January 1 (which is the Octave of Christmas), we celebrate the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God. Honoring Mary as the Mother of God can be traced back centuries, to the early days of the Church. The celebration has carried a few titles during this time, including the celebration of the Maternity of the Blessed Virgin Mary (7th century) and the Feast of the Circumcision of Christ (13th century). Interestingly it was not until 1974 when Pope Paul VI removed the feast of the Circumcision of Christ from the liturgical calendar and replaced it with the feast of the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God, that Mary's feast day was brought back to January 1.

Today we are reminded of the role that the Blessed Virgin played in the plan of our salvation. Through the Holy Spirit, God the Father prepared Mary to conceive His Son so that he could live among people. Christ's birth was made possible when Mary embraced God's will and freely chose to cooperate with God's grace, proclaiming, "Be it done to me according to thy word". So, it is that this feast is a celebration of Mary's motherhood of Jesus. This, the most significant of her titles and roles – Mother of God – comes from the Greek Theotokos or "God-bearer".

Calling Mary "Mother of God" is the highest honor we can give her. The Church honors her as the Mother of God, looks to her as a model of perfect discipleship, and asks her to pray to God on our behalf. Just as Christmas honors Jesus as the "Prince of Peace", the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God, honors Mary as the "Queen of Peace."

ABOUT THE INFANT JESUS NOVENA

While there is a longstanding tradition in the Church of devotion to the Child Jesus, when people think of devotion



to the Infant Jesus today, a specific and more recent statue comes to mind. The famous statue of the Infant Jesus, standing upright with a crown on His head and an orb symbolizing kingship in his left hand and his right hand extending a blessing, was brought to Prague at the beginning of the 17th century and is still there. The statue's origin is not known, but miracles have been reported associated with the statue for those who have

venerated the Infant Jesus. Each year, the statue is paraded through the streets of Prague.

The Infant of Prague Novena is traditionally prayed during Christmastide. Historically, the feast day coincided with Feast of the Holy Name of Jesus but the calendar has changed over the years. It is often prayed leading up to either January 2nd or January 14th.

The Infant of Prague Novena will begin on Thursday, January 5th at 11:30 a.m. Please join us!
