Building a Community of Love For God so Loved the World John 3.16-18

his Sunday we celebrate the mystery of the Most Holy Trinity which is the "central mystery of Christian faith and life" (CCC 234). While the Trinity is a mystery our mind will never fully grasp we can still glean much spiritual fruit through prayerful reflection.

Firstly, we must remember that God is Love (1 John 4:16). In order for God to be Love itself, it stands to reason that He is "one but not solitary" (CCC 254). This is



because love requires a lover and a beloved. It is within the Trinity that an eternal exchange of Love exists. St. Augustine describes in his treaty "On the Trinity" that

the Father and the Son eternally look at each other with pure Love, and this unadulterated love is the Holy Spirit, existing for all ages.

Hence, through reflecting on this mystery we come to understand the immense importance of community and the sharing of love. As stewards, we are called to imitate this divine life of the Trinity. We can do this by living with our brothers and sisters and fellow parishioners in a community of love. Love requires sacrifice and is expressed not just in words, but in deeds (1 John 3:18). So, let us offer up our time and talents for the good of our parish and the Church. If we strive to create this community of love, we can take great consolation in knowing that we are abiding in the Trinity, for St. John says "whoever abides in love abides in God, and God abides in him" (1 John 4:16).

Summary

St. Augustine describes in his treaty "On the Trinity" that the Father and the Son eternally look at each other with pure Love, and this unadulterated love is the Holy Spirit, existing for all ages.

Hence, through reflecting on this mystery we come to understand the immense importance of community and the sharing of love. NOVENA TO THE SACRED HEART OF JESUS & THE IMMACULATE HEART OF MARY



The Sacred Heart of Jesus represents Christ's divine love for us. A human element of who Jesus is. The devotion especially emphasizes the compassion and longsuffering of the heart of Christ towards humanity. The Sacred Heart of Jesus is not only radiant with love for us, but it is a wounded heart, encircled by thorns, and pierced—the heart we tried to kill, a love we tried to extinguish.

Devotion to the Immaculate Heart of Mary focuses on Mary's love for God, her maternal love for her son, Jesus, and encourages us to imitate her humility, gratitude,

obedience, and adoration. The roses surrounding Mary's heart represent her sinlessness and purity, sweetness, and new life. The sword piercing the top of the heart represents her redemptive suffering as a "spiritual crucifixion." The two Hearts are linked by devotions, prayers and feasts.
