

Spreading Jesus' Fame The Man with an Unclean Spirit Mark 1: 22-28

In today's Gospel, we hear about Jesus delivering a man with an unclean spirit. When the crowds saw this great miracle, they were all amazed by Jesus' words and deeds and began to speak about Him in astonishment. The Gospel ends by saying that "at once Jesus' fame began to spread throughout the surrounding region of Galilee." The news of this miracle helped others in the region come to know about Jesus.

So too, as stewards of Christ we should share with others the wonderful deeds God has done for us. All of us who have chosen to follow Christ more closely have our



own testimony of how God entered into our lives. St. Peter says that it is important to "always be ready to make your defense to anyone who demands from you an accounting for the hope that is in you" (1 Peter 3:15). Therefore, whenever

someone asks us why

we take our faith and stewardship so seriously, we should be able to tell them why. These are prime opportunities to share the faith with others. The next time a family member or friend asks us why we choose to follow Christ, let us share with them how God has beautifully worked in our lives. This way, just as Jesus' fame spread in the Gospel, it can also spread here in the Archdiocese. Bishop Robert Barron says that *"the minute you walk outside of your church on Sunday you're in mission territory."* As stewards, let us live this missionary call and spread the good news of Jesus Christ.

Summary

In the Gospel today, it says that after Jesus healed a man with an unclean spirit that his *"fame began to spread throughout the surrounding region of Galilee."* So too, as stewards of Christ we should share the wonderful deeds God has done for us in order to evangelize those around us. This way,

just as Jesus' fame spread in the Gospel, it can also spread here in the Archdiocese

PRESENTATION OF THE LORD Friday, February 2nd at 12:05 pm

U ou are invited to bring your own candles, and they will blessed during the Mass.

What was the presentation of Jesus?

We celebrate the Presentation of Jesus in the temple in Jerusalem; this is also celebrated as the feast of Candlemas(s) and in many churches it marks the formal end of the Christmas season.

What is the meaning of Candlemas in the Catholic church?

Candlemas, Christian festival on February 2nd commemorating the occasion when the Virgin Mary, in obedience to Jewish law, went to the Temple in Jerusalem both to be purified 40 days after the birth of her son, Jesus, and to present him to God as her firstborn (Luke 2:22–38).

Is Candlemas a holy day of obligation?

Despite not being a holy day of obligation, it is a significant day in the Church's calendar, one that marks the conclusion of the Christmas Cycle and anticipates the light that will vanquish all darkness at the Easter Vigil.

What is the lesson from the presentation of Jesus in the temple?

One might say that Mary and Joseph recognized Christ as a gift, not a possession, and presented Him to His Father in the temple. We, too, can recognize that our lives really belong to God. Through baptism, we belong to Christ. They also showed humility in this scene of the Presentation.

What is the Mass of the presentation of the Lord?

But Mary remained always committed to God's will and to her Son. Feb. 2 is on the liturgical calendar as the feast of the Presentation of the Lord, but in addition to the presentation, the Mass recalls Mary's humble submission to the purification ritual.

What is the meaning of the presentation in the joyful mysteries?

The Presentation is the Mystery of Obedience, of the miracles that happen when we simply do what God asks of us.

Why is the presentation in the temple a joyful mystery?

Salvation comes at a cost, as Jesus gives his life for us. But this, too, is a cause for joy. As we meditate on his Presentation, we rejoice that Salvation has come to us and has given his life for us.
