ST. ANTHONY OF PADUA**Patron of the Lost****Feast Day – June 13th**

St. Anthony of Padua, priest and Doctor of the Church, is the patron saint of lost items, lost people, lost souls, stolen articles, amputees, and travelers.



“It’s lost?” “Yeah. I have no idea where I left it.” “Pray to St. Anthony. It always works.” Such conversations probably happen often in Catholic households—perhaps in yours. Anthony is the patron saint of lost things, and I know I’m not the only Catholic who asks him to intercede for me. And the item turns up, often in a place I have already looked.

Born Fernando Martins, this saint took a bit of time to find his place in the world. He joined the Augustinian order when he was fifteen and developed such a deep knowledge of the Bible that he was nicknamed the “Repository of Scripture.”

After several years, moved by the sacrifice of some Franciscan martyrs, Fernando received permission to join the Franciscan order, taking the name Anthony. On his first missionary trip, he fell ill and was then assigned to a hermitage, where he studied Scripture and led a quiet life of routine chores and prayer. His career as a preacher happened as if by accident. And, isn’t that how the Holy Spirit’s work often appears?

When no one else was available to speak at an ordination, the superior drafted Anthony at the last minute. He so astounded everyone with his knowledge of the Bible and his eloquent, simple delivery that the Franciscans immediately sent him out to preach. He drew such enormous crowds that, on occasion, a bodyguard had to protect him from eager followers.

In his Fifteenth Sermon after Pentecost, St. Anthony made a timeless point: *“Do you want to have God always in your mind? Be just as he made you to be. Do not go seeking another ‘you’. Do not make yourself otherwise than he made you. Then you will always have God in mind.”* He had experienced the wisdom of those words. Quiet, dutiful St. Anthony was personally approved by St. Francis of Assisi to be the theology teacher to the Franciscans. St. Anthony settled in Padua after being named the provincial superior of northern Italy. He died there at the age of thirty-five.

St. Anthony’s patronage of lost articles may be rooted in an actual incident, though the circumstances have probably been embellished. A novice took Anthony’s book of psalms with him when he quit the order. The book was treasured not only as Scripture, but for the margin notes Anthony had scribbled in it. Anthony prayed for the

book to be returned, and it’s said that God answered the prayer and even one-upped the saint: the novice returned the book and returned to the order, too.

Do you ever feel lost? Ask St. Anthony to help you find the “you” God created you to be. *“If things created are so full of loveliness,”* St. Anthony said, *“how resplendent with beauty must be he who made them! The wisdom of the worker is apparent in his handiwork.”*

Anthony was declared a Doctor of the Church in 1946.

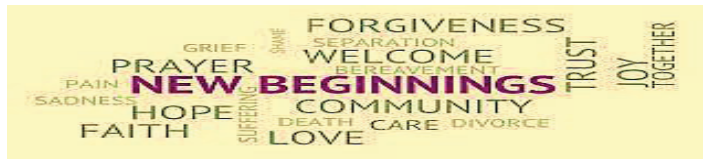
